OVERVIEW:

Beginning January 10, 2011, Maryland State Lottery Agency ("Lottery" or "Maryland Lottery") players will have a chance to win one of a total of 37 Cruise Vacation Prizes associated with the Maryland Lottery's Cruise for Cash Scratch-Off ticket game #851 ("Ticket"). (Players and winners are sometimes referred to as "you" or "your".) Players can scratch to instantly win 1 of 31 Royal Caribbean® International Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prizes ("Instant Win Cruise Prize(s)"), or enter a non-winning Ticket in the Maryland Lottery Cruise for Cash 2nd Chance Drawing ("2nd Chance Drawing" or "2nd Chance Drawings"; drawings within the 2nd Chance Drawing are referred to as "Drawing" or "Drawings") for a chance to win 1 of 6 Royal Caribbean® International 2nd Chance Cruise vacation prizes ("2nd Chance Cruise Prize(s)"). Six (6) Drawings will be held to give away the six (6) 2nd Chance Cruise Prizes. (Royal Caribbean® International Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prizes and Royal Caribbean® International 2nd Chance Cruise Vacation Prizes are sometimes referred to as "Cruise Vacation Prize" or "Cruise Vacation Prizes." Royal Caribbean® International Instant Win Cruise Vacations and Royal Caribbean® International 2nd Chance Cruise Vacations are sometimes referred to as "Cruise Vacation" or "Cruise Vacations".)

Royal Caribbean® International Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prizes:

Scratch to instantly win 1 of 31 Royal Caribbean® Cruise Vacation Prizes for you and a guest to enjoy a seven (7) night cruise vacation on a Royal Caribbean cruise ship to its respective Caribbean port. Each winner will work with a designated travel agent to book the trip that best fits his or her needs. Book a cruise any time of the year. No blackout dates. Enjoy a premium ocean view balcony stateroom for two, \$1,000 in onboard spend credit for incidental items such as: beverage service, shore excursions, purchases made during the cruise and/or similar expenditures. You will be responsible for any additional charges including sales taxes once your onboard spend credit is depleted. Additionally, \$500 spending money will be provided not less than ten (10) days prior to departure. Included is first-class round-trip airfare for two (2) on a national airline from any major Maryland airport (or closest major airport as may be reasonably required for departure within the same price range. Winners may be responsible for air transportation costs above that price range.) Premium hotel room accommodations for two (2) at a deluxe hotel will be provided for the night prior to cruise departure. This Cruise Vacation Prize includes transfers/transportation to and from the winner's home, the airports and the ship, all gratuities on the ship, and all trip related sales and destination/departure taxes. Each of the 31 Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prizes has a value of \$8,296. Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prize winners should list one name only on the back of the Ticket, or the Lottery will choose which name is the winner. See the Claiming section for instructions on how to claim your Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prize.

Royal Caribbean® International 2nd Chance Cruise Vacation Prizes:

If you didn't win an Instant Win Cruise Prize or a cash prize on the Ticket, enter your non-winning Ticket in a Maryland Lottery Cruise for Cash 2nd Chance Drawing for an opportunity to win 1 of 6 Royal Caribbean® International 2nd Chance Cruise Vacation Prizes for you and a guest to enjoy a nine (9) night cruise on one of Royal Caribbean's cruise ships departing from the Port of Baltimore to its respective Caribbean port. Some of the cruise features include ice skating rinks, rock climbing walls, elegant dining rooms and relaxing spas. Available features vary from ship to ship. Each winner will work with a designated travel agent to book the trip that best fits his or her needs. Book a cruise any time of the year. No blackout dates. Enjoy a premium ocean view balcony stateroom for two and \$1,000 in onboard spend credit for incidental items such as: beverage service, shore excursions, purchases made during the cruise and/or similar expenditures. You will be responsible for any additional charges including sales taxes once your onboard spend credit is depleted. This 2nd Chance Cruise Prize includes transfers/transportation to and from the winner's home and the ship within the State of Maryland (reasonable accommodations within the same price range will be made for non-Maryland residents; winners may be responsible for transfers/transportation costs above that price range), all gratuities on the ship, and all trip related sales and destination/departure taxes. Entries for Drawings must be received by 6:30 PM EST on February 9, 2011, March 9, 2011, April 6, 2011, May 4, 2011, June 8, 2011, and July 13, 2011, respectively. The winner for each respective Drawing will be announced at mdlottery.com/cruise on or about February 17, 2011, March 17, 2011, April 14, 2011, May 12, 2011, June 16, 2011 and July 21, 2011. Entries are included in only one Drawing. You must enter each Drawing separately to be included in that Drawing. Each of the 2nd Chance Cruise Prizes has a value of \$5,016.00

For All Cruise Vacation Prizes:

Travel outside of the United States, including to the Caribbean, requires a valid Passport. Winners without a passport may pick up U.S. Passport Application forms at certain U.S. Post Offices that process U.S. Passport Applications. Any winners, regardless of passport held, should check with a U.S. Passport Office or your embassy for any further requirements. It is the winners' and guests' responsibility to have a valid, current passport. Lottery has no liability if winner and/or guest does not have a valid, current passport.

TWO WAYS TO ENTER THE 2ND CHANCE DRAWINGS:

There are two ways to enter the 2nd Chance Drawings: 1) at mdlottery.com/cruise, or 2) via the postal mail. Players entering at mdlottery.com/cruise MUST KEEP your original Ticket. You MUST present it to the Maryland Lottery to validate your online entry if you win. See the Claiming section for instructions on how to claim your 2nd Chance Cruise Prize.

Entries for the Maryland Lottery Cruise for Cash 2nd Chance Drawing will be accepted at any time beginning January 10, 2011 at 5:30 AM Eastern Standard Time ("EST") through 6:30 PM EST of the final entry date, July 13, 2011.

Six (6) Drawings, one for each of the six (6) Royal Caribbean 2nd Chance cruise vacation prizes, will be held. Entry deadlines for each Drawing are: February 9, 2011, March 9, 2011, April 6, 2011, May 4, 2011, June 8, 2011 and July 13, 2011. Entries are included in one Drawing only. You must enter each Drawing separately to be included in that Drawing. Entries must be received by 6:30 PM EST of the entry deadline date to be included in that Drawing. Only non-winning Maryland Lottery Cruise for Cash Scratch-Off tickets (game #851) are eligible for entry into a Drawing.

HOW TO ENTER A 2ND CHANCE DRAWING

At mdlottery.com/cruise:

To enter a Drawing online, go to mdlottery.com/cruise. The first time you visit mdlottery.com/cruise you will be required to register and set up a personal account, where you will be able to enter the 13-digit VIRN number (validation code) located under the latex on the front of your non-winning Cruise for Cash Scratch-Off ticket, your name, address (street, city, zip code), email address (and optionally, phone number) in the provided fields. The Ticket must be a non-winning Ticket. You will receive an on-screen confirmation message and confirmation email acknowledging that your entry has been accepted. Only the VIRN number from a Maryland Lottery Cruise for Cash Scratch-Off ticket (Game #851) will be eligible for entry into the Cruise for Cash 2nd Chance Drawings at mdlottery.com/cruise. Each VIRN number entered online from a Cruise for Cash Scratch-Off ticket is eligible to enter, and to win, only once. **YOU MUST KEEP YOUR ORIGINAL TICKET, AND YOU MUST PRESENT IT TO THE MARYLAND LOTTERY TO VALIDATE YOUR ONLINE ENTRY IF YOU WIN. You can enter the VIRN number on your Ticket at any time throughout the 2nd Chance Drawing period. However, entries must be registered by 6:30 PM EST on the announced deadline date to be eligible for that Drawing.**

Via Postal Mail:

To enter a Drawing via postal mail, fill out the back of a non-winning Ticket, including your name, address, city, zip (and optionally, phone number and/or email address), sign the back of your Ticket and send to:

Entries must be mailed in a standard #10 envelope (4-1/8" x 9-1/2") and must contain a Maryland postmark. Each mailing will be considered as one entry, even if the mailing contains more than one (1) non-winning Ticket. If more than one Ticket is enclosed in one envelope, the Lottery will randomly choose one Ticket as the entry. All other tickets within that envelope will not be considered.

Both Forms of Entry: Entries submitted should list one name only, or the Lottery will choose which name is the winner. No ticket other than non-winning Maryland Lottery Cruise for Cash Scratch-Off tickets (#851) may be used to enter any of these Drawings. Cruise for Cash tickets originally winning on the ticket itself are not valid entries and will not be considered.

You may enter as often as you like; however, you may only win a 2nd Chance Cruise Prize once. Double entries from one ticket (e.g., online and mail-in) will be disqualified. The Cruise for Cash 2nd Chance Drawings are governed by these Official Rules and Conditions of Eligibility ("Rules"). By participating in any Drawing, you agree to be bound by these Rules.

You must be 18 years or older to enter. These are bonus drawings with bonus prizes.

The Lottery reserves the right to reschedule any times and dates regarding any of the Drawings in this 2nd Chance Drawing, if necessary, without advance notice. A "drawing" includes any random selection event.

CLAIMING:

All winners must complete a Lottery Claim Form, including Social Security number (SSN), and must provide proof of your SSN and furnish photo I.D. proof of being at least 18 years of age. You may not request a substitute or equivalent prize for any prize. Actual prizes may vary, depending on availability. Once you have claimed your prize and been verified, you will be given a completed copy of your Claim Form and information regarding the fulfillment of your Cruise Vacation Prize, and your winner information will be provided to Alchemy3, LLC ("Alchemy"). Alchemy will handle all fulfillment matters, including all questions, complaints and problems. You will have one year after Claiming your Cruise Vacation Prize to book your Cruise Vacation. To book your Cruise Vacation, contact Alchemy's Winner Services at the toll-free number on your Winner's Certificate. Winners will work with a travel agent to book the trip that best fits your needs. You have up to one year from booking your Cruise Vacation to take your cruise. All persons traveling on the Instant Win or 2nd Chance Cruise Vacations must accept and be bound by the terms and conditions of these Rules and other applicable rules, regulations and statutes, must sign a waiver and release of all liability, and ensure that their guest signs a waiver and release of all liability. Cruise Vacation Prize winners must also retain both the Claim Form and instructions for fulfilling your Cruise Vacation Prize, and follow the instructions to confirm your travel and meet any deadlines. In the event that your Cruise Vacation Prize is cancelled or rescheduled, the Lottery may substitute a prize of equivalent value; however, that prize might not be for the same date. Cruise Vacation Prizes may not be sold. Cruise Vacation Prizes may not be used by anyone other than prize winner without the Lottery Director's approval.

Each winner and guest must travel together. If winner and/or guest fails to arrive at their elected/designated time of departure, their entire Cruise Vacation Prize, except spending money, shall be forfeited.

Players should understand that air travel and cruise ship travel are subject to forces beyond the control of the Maryland Lottery, Alchemy and Royal Caribbean® and the Maryland Lottery is not liable for any delays or events. Players further understand and agree that the Maryland Lottery reserves the right in its sole discretion, a) to substitute a prize of equivalent value for any Cruise Vacation Prize in the event that circumstances warrant this change, or b) to reschedule the fulfillment of the Cruise Vacation Prize. Winners do not have the option to substitute anything, including a cash prize, for these Cruise Vacation Prizes or for any other prize.

As a further bonus prize, the Lottery will pay the required estimated State and Federal tax withholdings on the Instant Win and 2nd Chance Cruise Vacation Prizes. Further amounts may be owed. The payment of tax withholdings could result in additional Federal and State tax liability being due from the winner. Winner is responsible for all other taxes, including income taxes, in excess of withholdings paid by the Lottery. If you owe child support or certain other debts to a State agency or other governmental entity, any amount that would have been applied on your behalf as estimated tax withholdings or provided as the cash portion of any prize will be applied to your unpaid child support and/or to certain other debts owed to a State agency or other governmental entity. Those amounts will be added to your reportable income. You will be taxed on those amounts.

Royal Caribbean® Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prizes:

Each winner of the Royal Caribbean® Instant Win Cruise Vacation Prize must claim your prize in person at the Maryland Lottery Baltimore Customer Resource Center, Montgomery Park Business Center, 1800 Washington Boulevard, Suite 330, Baltimore, MD 21230 by 4:30 PM EST within 182 days after the announced end of game for the Cruise for Cash scratch-off ticket (#851).

Royal Caribbean® 2nd Chance Cruise Vacation Prizes:

All winners of the Cruise For Cash 2nd Chance Drawings will be notified via telephone, e-mail, and/or certified mail to confirm eligibility. The Lottery, in its sole discretion, may choose to use additional or alternate means or methods to notify the winners. You will be advised, at the time of notification, of claiming procedures. **Winners of a 2nd Chance Cruise Prize will have 60 days from the date of the Drawing to claim your prize**, and you must claim your prize in person at the Maryland Lottery Baltimore Customer Resource Center, Montgomery Park Business Center, 1800 Washington Boulevard, Suite 330, Baltimore, MD 21230 by 4:30 PM EST on those respective dates. You agree that if a winner has not claimed or been confirmed as eligible or has not submitted all required claiming documentation within 60 days after the date of the Drawing, the Lottery may select an alternate winner. All alternate winners must claim your winnings no later than 4:30 PM EST within 14 days after notification.

If you win via your Internet entry, you must present your original, physical Ticket with the correct matching registered 13-digit VIRN number and with the registered name related to your Internet entry in order to claim your prize. If the name on the Ticket does not match the name on the Internet entry, then the entry is invalid. If more than one name is provided on any winning entry, the prize will be deemed won by the name registered on the Internet.

The Lottery reserves the right to appoint a proxy or stand-in if the winner's or winner's proxy's clothing or behavior is not acceptable, or as otherwise determined by the Lottery, in the Lottery's reasonable sole discretion.

By submitting an entry for this 2nd Chance Drawing, you consent and agree to the following:
